## Bruker ALPHA II FTIR DRYING GUIDE

- 1. Make sure the FTIR is connected to the laptop
- 2. Open internet explorer on laptop
- 3. Enter web address in search bar: <a href="http://10.10.0.1/">http://10.10.0.1/</a> or the address assigned
- 4. Select Service
- 5. Select Full Report
- 6. Find the relative humidity: it should always be under 30%.
- 7. If humidity is over 30%, follow steps to dry or replace the desiccant bags.
- 8. Disconnect FTIR power supply
- 9. Disconnect network cable from FTIR
- 10. Wait until the FTIR has cooled completely
- 11. Loosen the 4 screws of the rear cover using a screwdriver
- 12. Remove the used desiccant bags: make sure to not cut or tear the bags
- 13. Reattach the 4 screws and close the cover
- 14. Place the bags in a plastic bag to carry to a location where there is an oven
- 15. Place the used bags on a tray in an oven at 130°C or 266°F for at least 10 minutes.
- 16. Do Not use the FTIR while desiccant are removed
- 17. Once dried, reinsert the bags into their slot
- 18. Loosen the 4 screws of the rear cover
- 19. Fold bags onto themselves, and reinsert them into their slots
- 20. Reattach the 4 screws and close the cover
- 21. Connect power supply and connect to laptop
- 22. Follow steps 2-6 to run another full report to check if the humidity is in the appropriate range
- 23. Wait approximately 2 24 hours if humidity is still over 30%
- 24. Repeat steps if needed
